Figure G.1: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6" map showing Sites 1, 2 and 9

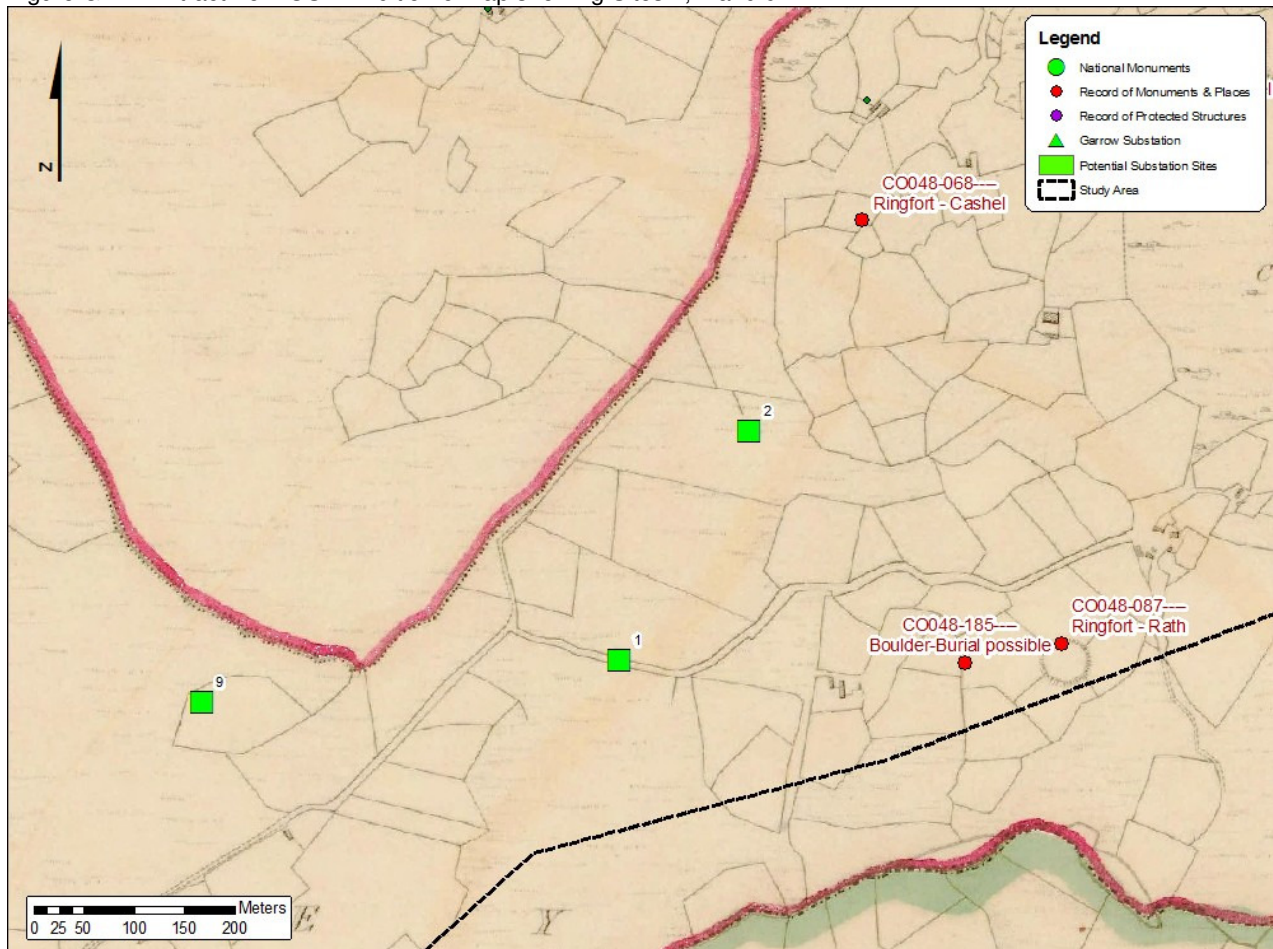


Figure G.2: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6" map showing Sites 3, 4 and 10

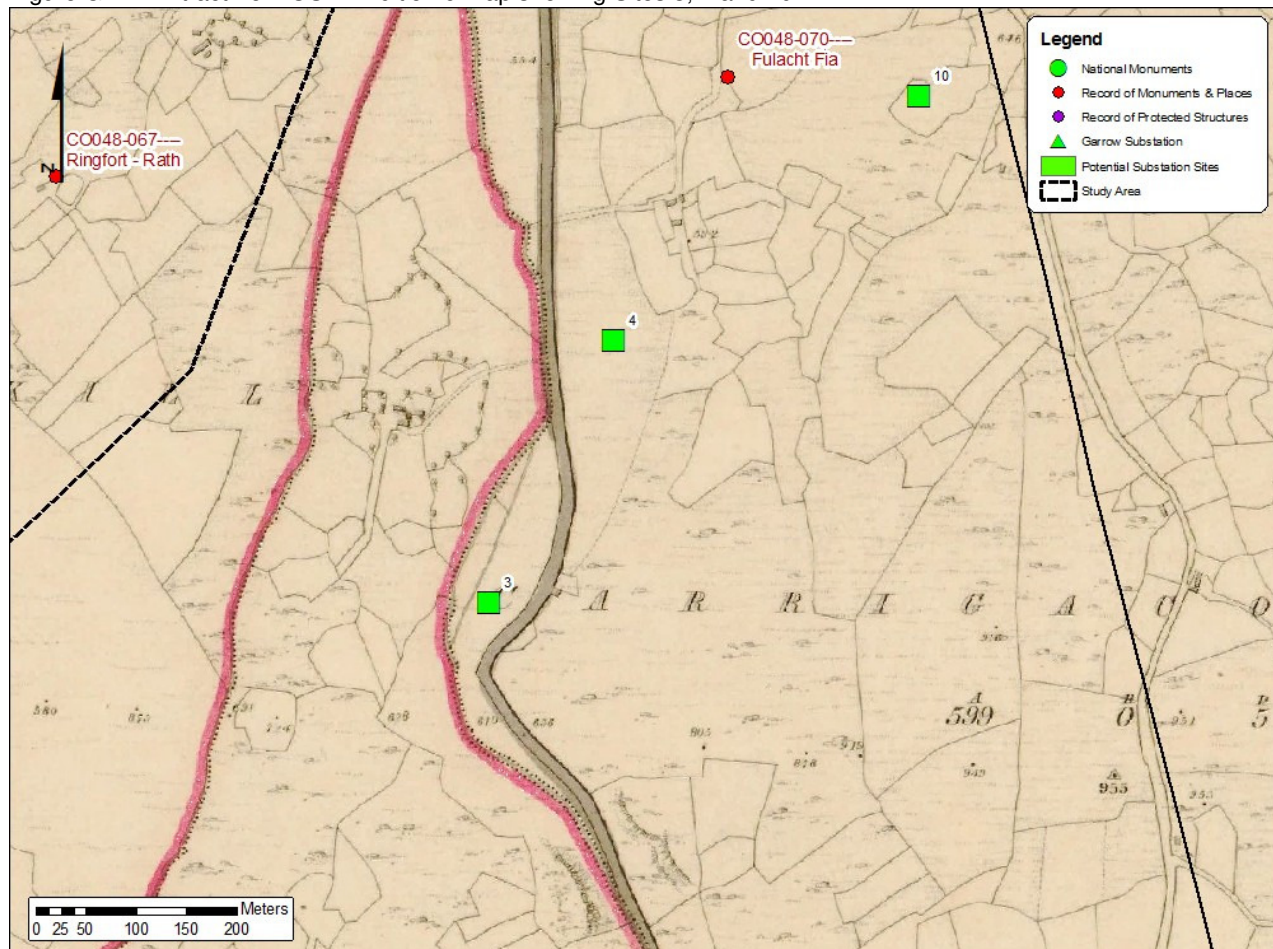


Figure G.3: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6"map showing Site 5

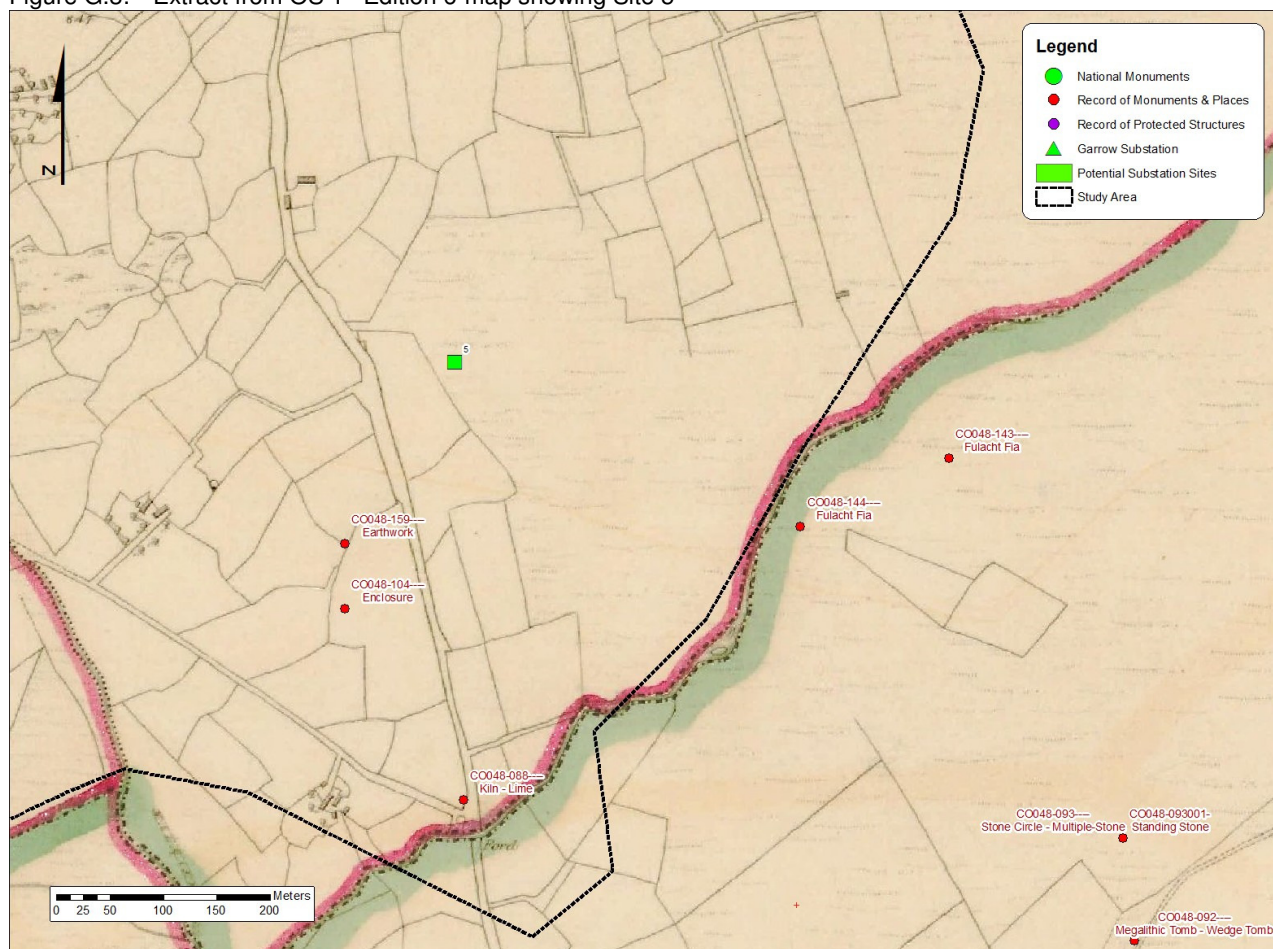


Figure G.4: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6"map showing Site 6

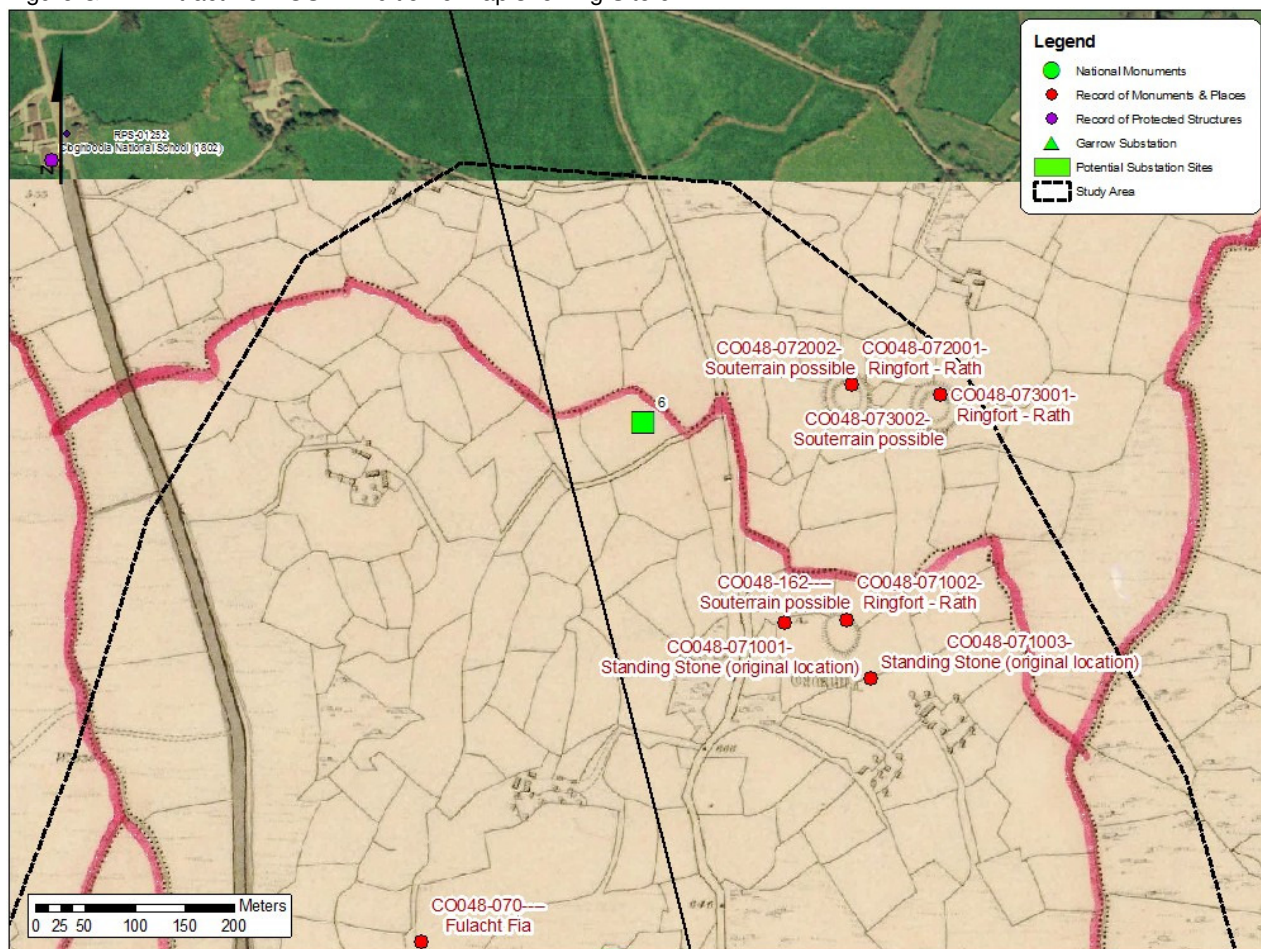


Figure G.5: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6" map showing Site 10 (and 4)

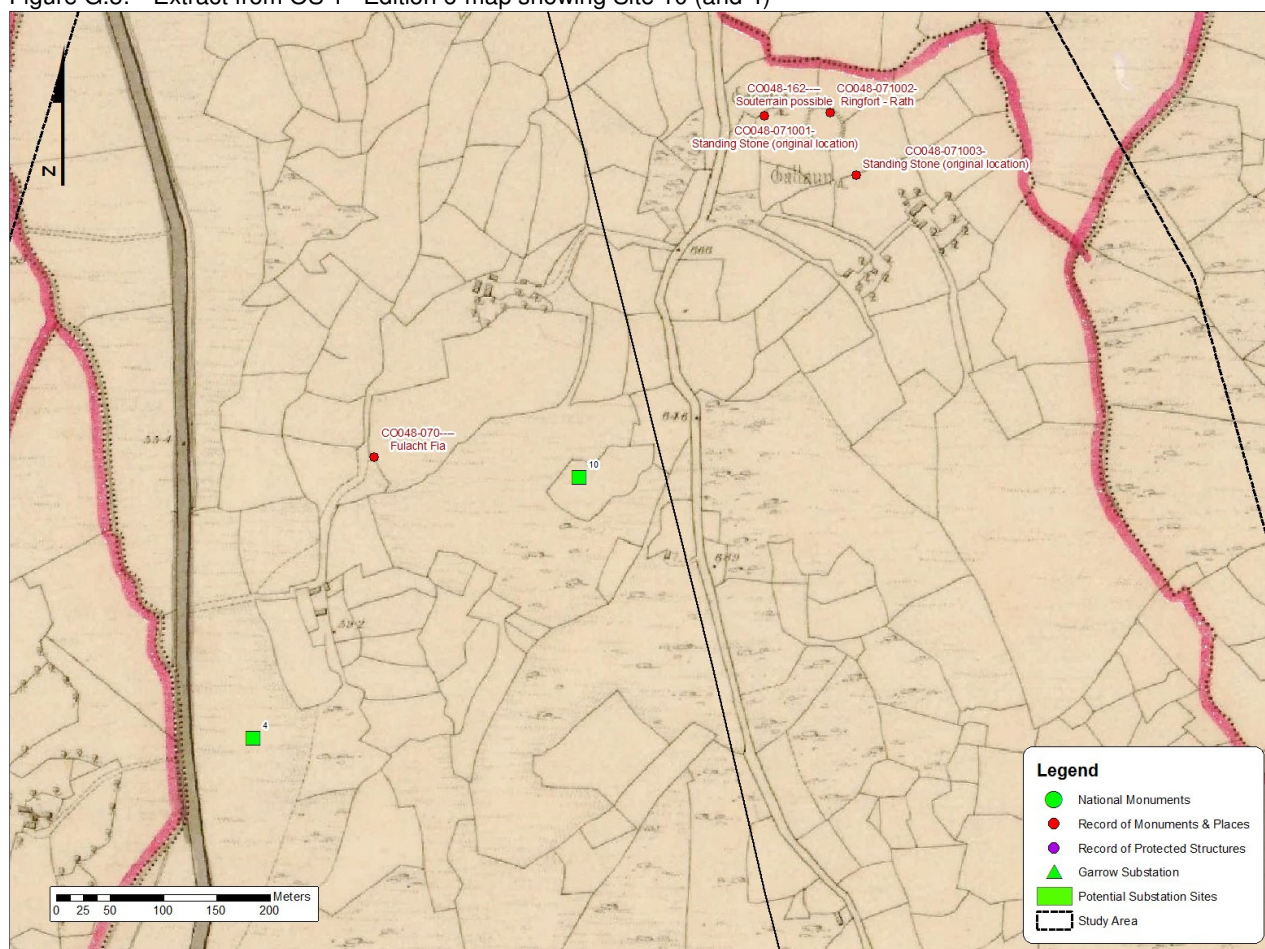
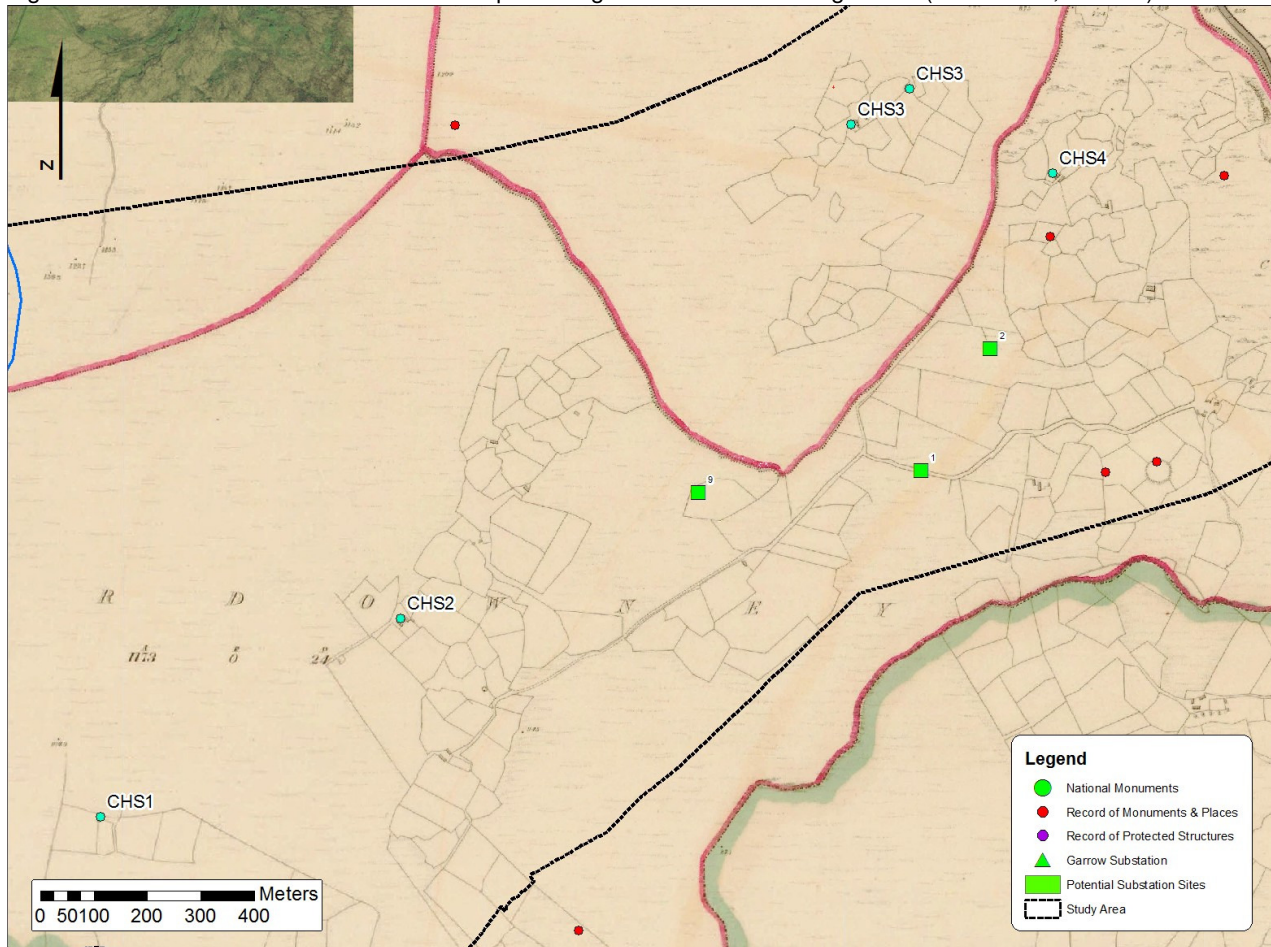


Figure G.6: Extract from OS 1st Edition 6"map showing Other Cultural Heritage Sites (and Sites 1, 2 and 9)

Figure G.7: Aerial photograph showing proposed substation locations Sites 1, 2 and 9 and surrounding recorded monuments

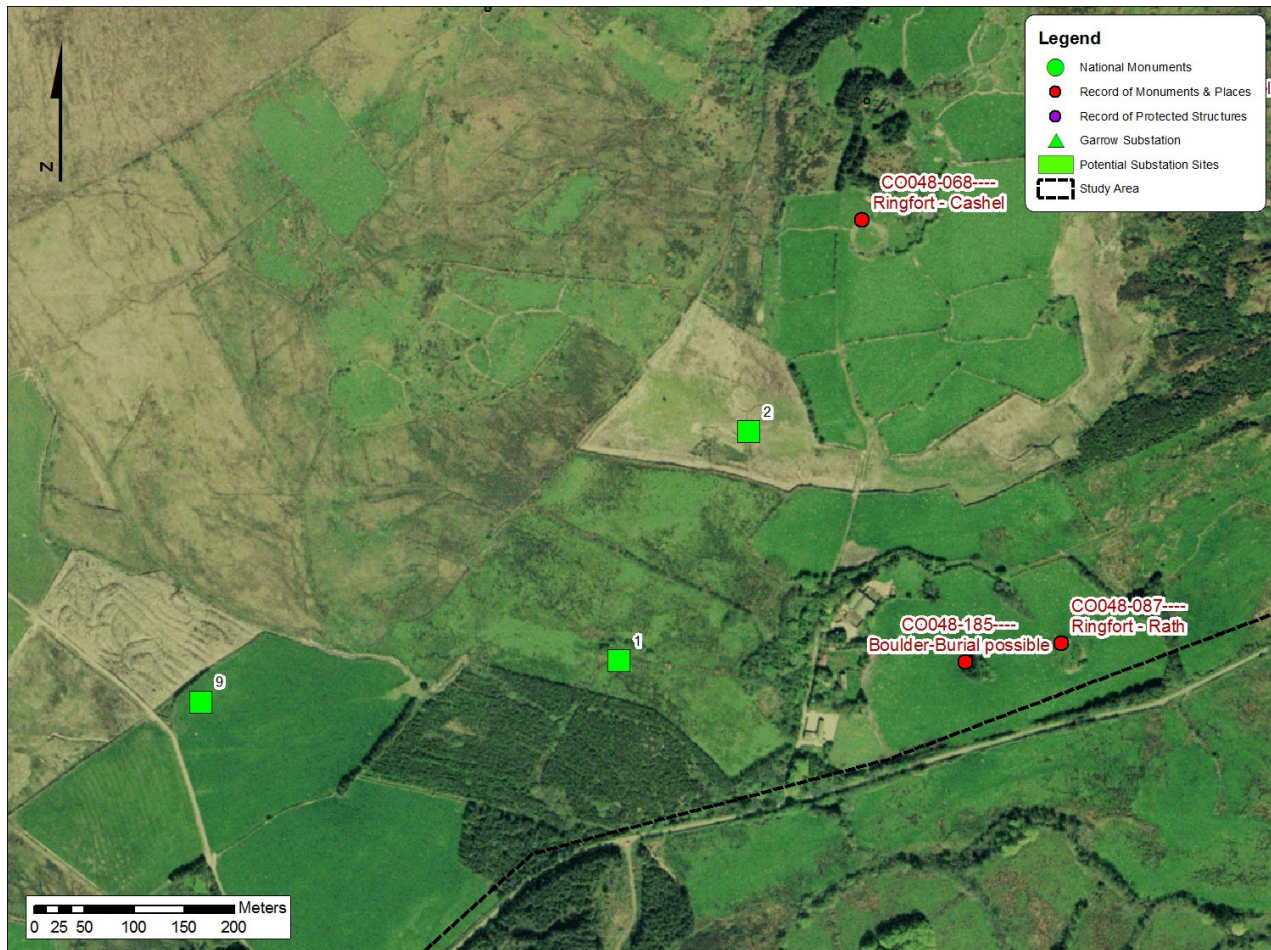


Figure G.8: Aerial photograph showing proposed substation locations Sites 3, 4 and 10 and surrounding recorded monuments

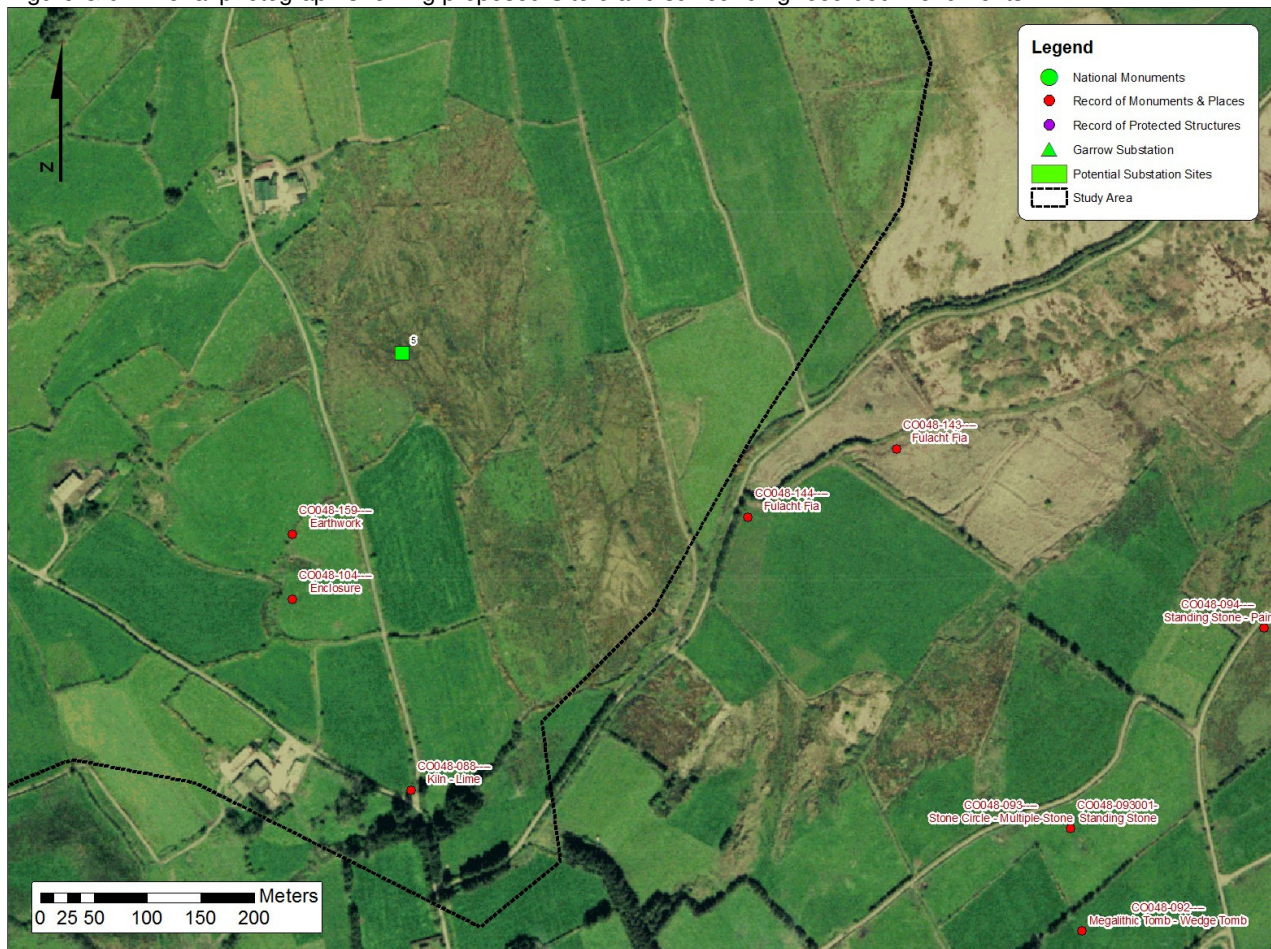


Figure G.10: Aerial photograph showing Site 6 and surrounding recorded monuments

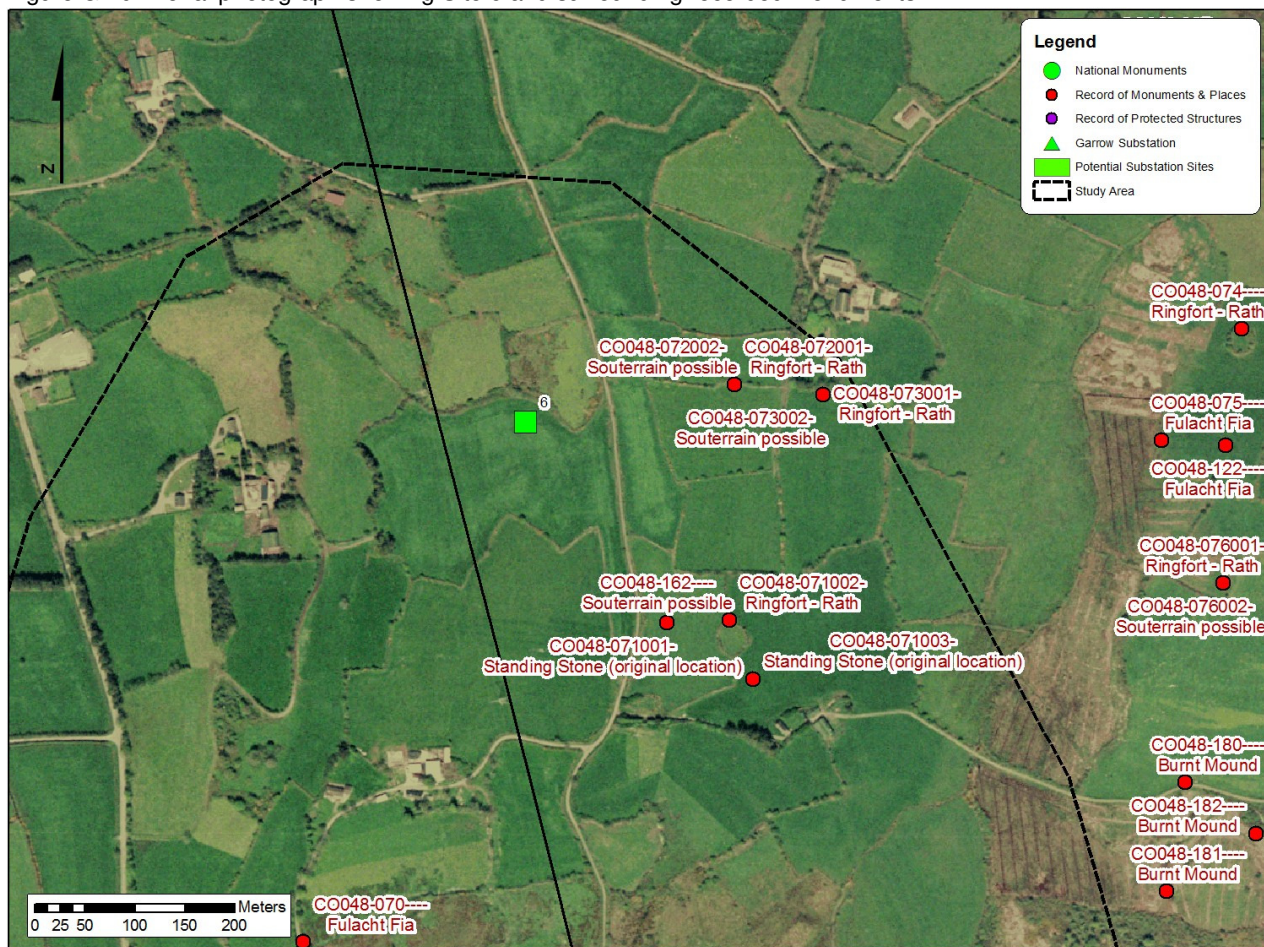


Figure G.11: Aerial photograph showing Site 10 (and 4) and surrounding recorded monuments

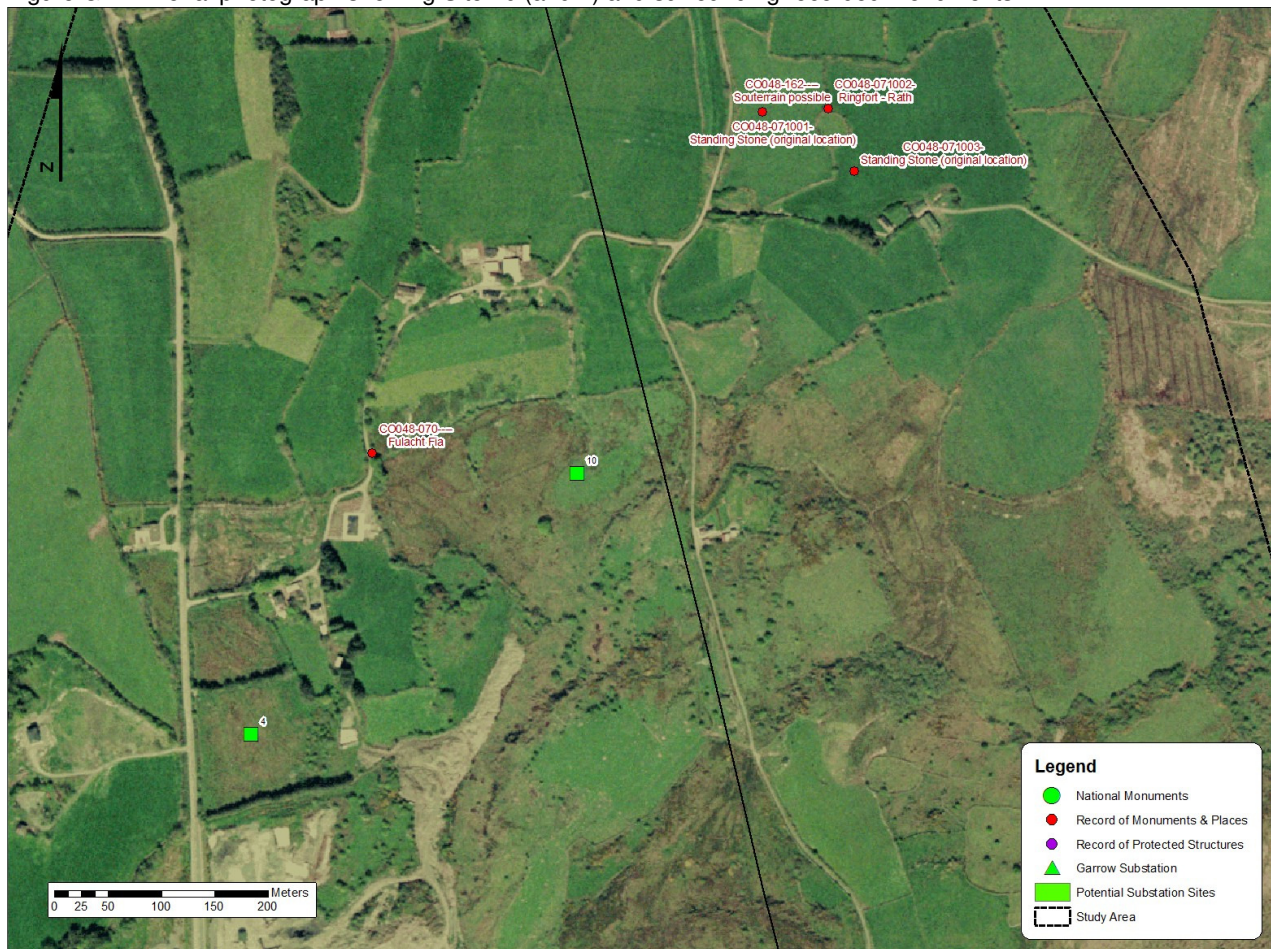


Figure G.12: Aerial photograph showing other Cultural Heritage Sites (and Sites 1, 2 and 9)
