

EirGrid TSO Stakeholder Engagement Plan 2020

Consultation Note

19 February 2020



Overview

On 23 May 2018 the CRU published its PR4 Reporting and Incentives Decision Paper (CER/18/087). Decision 8 of CER/18/087 sets out the CRU's objectives in terms of incentivising the TSO on the quality of its stakeholder engagement, to enable the potential benefits of effective stakeholder engagement to be realised in practice. The Decision states:

- *The TSO shall be subject to a financial incentive on the scope, quality and outcomes/impacts of its stakeholder engagement activities.*
- *Performance shall be measured through an annual assessment of the TSO's strategy for stakeholder engagement, and the processes and activities undertaken by the TSO pursuant to that strategy over the preceding calendar year. The evidence to inform this assessment shall take the form of an annual submission by the TSO, consistent with guidance set by the CRU.*
- *The assessment shall be undertaken by a panel constituted by the CRU for this purpose and chaired by a CRU Commissioner – and conclude with the award of a score on a scale of 1 to 10, consistent with guidance set by the CRU. The initial guidance on the submission and the assessment criteria is in Annex E.*

Continuous improvement is a principle that underpins all our work and stakeholders' feedback both on our engagement processes is key to this.

We are now publishing our 2020 Stakeholder Engagement Plan for a four-week consultation asking the following questions:

- 1) *Do Stakeholders have any feedback on our 2020 Stakeholder Engagement Plan?*
- 2) *Would stakeholders like to see any further information covered in future EirGrid's Stakeholder Engagement Plans?*
- 3) *Do stakeholders have any view on the direction EirGrid's Stakeholder Engagement should be going in coming years?*
